Summary

Performs duties as assigned under the direction of the Recreation Manager. This position is responsible for officiating youth futsal matches.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Show up 15 minutes prior to every assigned game.
- Dress appropriately in required gear.
- Start and end games according to the schedule.
- Examine safety of equipment and playing area.
- Supervise and control the general conduct of all participants in the game.
- Assist in the set up and take down of equipment.
- Work directly with the participants in a professional, courteous and friendly manner.
- Enforce all rules, regulations, and safety practices for all participants.
- Promptly report all accidents, injuries and significant incidents to the Rec Manager.
- Other related duties as assigned.

Education and Experience Requirements

Current or former high school level player and above preferred. Basic knowledge of the sport. Previous referee experience is a plus. Appropriate sport and Basic First Aid and CPR/AED certification.

Physical Requirements

Regularly required to stand, walk, run, reach with hands/arms, and stoop, kneel, or crouch. Requires clarity of vision and three-dimensional vision. Occasionally required to lift and carry up to 25 pounds.
