## The Benefits of Trees

The benefits trees provide can be divided into four categories: social, community, environmental, and economic.

# Social benefits include:

Making our community a more pleasant and appealing place to live work and play • Trees are comforting to people • Trees help provide a "sense of place".

## Community benefits include:

Screening of objectionable views • Increasing privacy • Reducing glare and reflection • Directing pedestrian traffic • Decreasing auto speeds • Complementing architecture.

# Environment benefits include:

Improving the air we breathe • Cooling warm urban areas • Increasing wildlife habitat • Conserving and purifying water • Moderating the effects of the sun, wind and rain.

## Economic benefits include:

Energy cost reductions • Increased property values • Storm water mitigation (reduction in the amount of polluted runoff or erosion that reaches the public storm water system) • Erosion control.
